SCC is a European Innovation Partnership dedicated to *demonstrating commercial-scale smart city solutions* in a small number of locations, thus supporting European cities and communities to meet their commitments in energy, transport, air quality or climate change mitigation. This Partnership ultimately looks to **establish strategic partnerships between industry and European cities to develop the urban systems and infrastructures of tomorrow**.

The next phase "Lighthouse projects" (large scale projects) should offer solutions to the broad range of geographical, spatial & demographic characteristics of European cities, including but not limited to:

- Smart buildings and neighbourhoods
- Smart supply and demand systems and services for better-informed citizens
- Sustainable urban mobility
- Smart and sustainable digital infrastructures
- Strategic planning for identification, integration and optimisation of flows
- (energy, emissions, people, goods, services)
